The various events of the week are the biggest single source of fundraising for the SIDS Network of Ohio, which raises money for education, grief support and research into Sudden Infant Death Syndrome. Many babies still die each year from SIDS, but accurate statistics are unavailable. The de Cavells lost their first daughter to it.






"Annette and I are so thankful to our friends in both the restaurant community and those who have supported us all these years," de Cavell said Wednesday. "Every year, thousands of families are affected by SIDS - parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, friends. So, if by doing this event every year we can put some focus on SIDS and raise money to help families like ours, then we will have done some good."

The biggest event of the week is, appropriately, for families. The Family Day Brunch is June 13, from 11 a.m.-2 p.m. at the Midwest Culinary Institute at Cincinnati State Technical and Community College. It's \$65 for adults, \$15 for children 3-12. (At the door admission goes up to \$75 and \$20.)






